- **Poster presentation (5 minutes for presentation, discussion at the poster).**

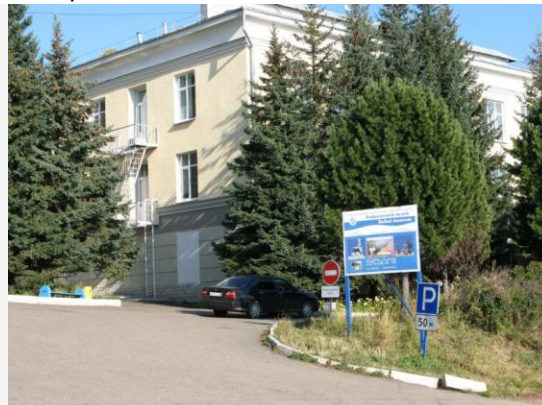
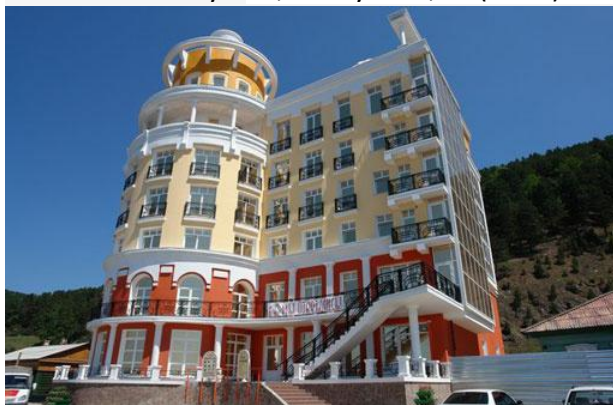

The abstract should be concise and present the aim of the work, essential results and conclusion. It should be typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt, single-spaced, justified. The length should **not exceed 250 words**.

Papers presented at the Symposium will be published in peer-reviewed journals *Advances in Limnology* and *The Bulletin of Irkutsk State University. Series Biology and Ecology*. Manuscripts should be received by the organizer no later than September 30, 2014.

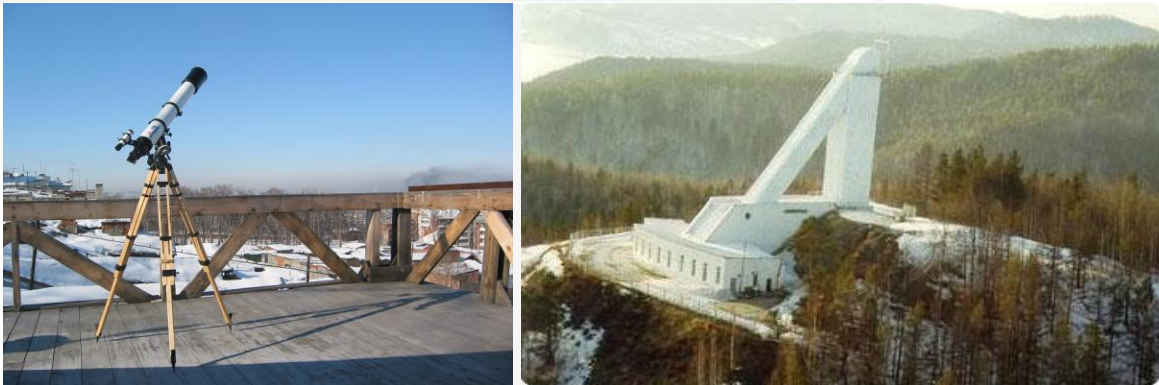
